The theme for the May on-the-water meeting at Silver Lake was "Warship Day". Most of the rugulars turned out, as well some others.

Eric Bertlesen was there with his USCGC Mohawk. The 1/92 model is based on the Scale Shipyard hull, and the superstructure is built from the lightweight foam-core kit from Eric's Homeport Models. As a former crew member of one of Mohawk's sisterships, I can say with authority that Eric's model is very good!

Also on the water was Bob Okerholm's magnificent USS John Hancock, which is also in 1/96 scale. Eric and Bob ran their models together, sailing in a loose formation around the pond. They looked very good together!



Glenn Williams brought along his model of a New York City Staten Island Ferry—the John F Kennedy. The Kennedy is the lead ferry of the class of three boats, and the only one still in service. Modeled in HO (1/87) scale, the model is over 3 feet long. The ferry is a true double-ender, with a prop and rudder at each end. He has made some great progress on his ferry since we last saw him.

Glenn brought the model along to the float to run some sea trials. As often happens in early trials, he found some problems that limited his time on the water. But as he said, it is always better to find them now than later! We're all looking forward to the next time he brings the model out to the pond!
