We had a nice day to start the season. Attendees included: Bob and Johanna Okerholm, Ed and Linda Arini, Mike Hale, Shaun Kimball, Willi Zankel, Mike Fioretti, Bob Prezioso and Glenn Williams.

As planned, Paul Jermain was there to do the TV show taping that Mike Hale had set up. It took a little time to set up tables with the best lighting for the boats and to prevent interruptions by passers-by. Paul and Mike did an introduction and then went into an explanation of the 10 boats Mike had brought-- 2 sail boats, a classic Chris craft, a PT boat, a duck, an air boat, 2 high speed boats and 2 big tugs- Minnie Jean and Sarah B. Paul then spent time with Bob Okerholm, discussing his Destroyer USS Hancock, his *Eastie* pleasure yacht and his *SafeSea* rescue tug.

Paul then moved on to Willi Zankel, and they discussed Willi's big salvage tug and his Creole Queen. After that Paul spent time with Shawn Kimball and his quartet of ready to run models.

With the interview portion completed, Paul then filmed runs of Mike's Sarah B, Bob's rescue tug, Willi's Creole (with music and smoke) and then Shaun's Battleship. The coverage ended with Paul and Mike discussing the information about the club.

The TV show is already airing in Northern Mass, Maine, Vermont, and New Hampshire. The programs featuring the RC boats will also be posted on the Smart Boating website in the next few days. There will be two shows, as Paul edits the material down to create 30 minute episodes.
