Below: Shaun Kimball's big *RMS Titanic*. The model is 1:150 scale, and is approximately 5' 10" long, 9" wide, and is 23" tall, (from the bottom of her keel to the tip of her masts). Shaun got her from the RC Scale Model Store. The model weighs roughly 30lbs and is moved by 3 motors linked together and controlled by one speed control. She doesn't have any working lights, but Shaun plans to install lights in the future.



Shaun reports that when she's in the water, she sails as gracefully as the real one did, and says "...the only difference between mine and the real Titanic is mine didn't sink on her maiden voyage!" Shaun has recently added some N-scale size people to the decks which includes Captain Edward John Smith, J. Bruce Ismay, and Thomas Andrew next to the bridge. He only has 41 people on board for now, but he says he will be adding more as time goes on.
