

The new 1/200 scale plastic model of the USS Hornet (CV-8) is now available. The kit features a big one piece hull, and will be close to 50 inches long when assembled. While sold as a display model, I've heard that people are already working on RC conversions.

This is a model of the WW2 Yorktown-class carrier, the one that launched the Doolittle Raid on Tokyo, and was later lost at the Battle of Midway.

The kit, by Merit International, is selling for around \$360. Merit has already announced that their next model will be a USS Iowa class Battleship in the same scale!
